This academic time affords students the chance to review and apply previously learned skills and knowledge as well as prepare for the upcoming school year. **Summer Journey's** educational goals are comprised of academic courses with hands-on instruction in **reading, language arts, math, and social studies and/or science**.

While the **Summer Journey** academic courses will be relaxed in format—no homework or tests for grades—we will also offer courses for hands-on exploration and discovery. There will be a variety of course offerings for all age groups with an emphasis on fun learning and academic growth.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Summer Journey program?

The Lincoln County R-III School District *Summer Journey* is a <u>free</u> extended learning summer program operated by the Lincoln County R-III. Our goal is to provide a world-class educational experience to students.

Building Host Sites:

- Cuivre Park Elementary (MSE)
- Lincoln Elementary (WCE)
- Boone Elementary (CBE, HPE)
- Troy South Middle School (TMS)

When will the program be held?

The Lincoln County R-III School District Summer Journey operates daily, from 8:30am to 3:30pm for elementary, and 7:20am to 2:20pm for middle school students. The program will run beginning June 5 and ending on June 30, 2023.

Must my child be in attendance every hour of the program in order to receive credit for the *Summer Journey* program?

No. It is assumed that students may have vacations or camps planned. While incentives for good attendance are available to students, a child's occasional absence should not deter parents from enrolling their child(ren) in the program.

Will transportation be provided to and from the program?

Yes, transportation will be provided for those student families who qualify for transportation during the regular school year. However, bus routes will be limited and may vary from routes during the regular school year. **Transportation during Summer Journey is limited to one consistent address**.

Please complete the Summer School Transportation form and return to your child's school. Transportation information will be sent to those families who require transportation as soon as the plan becomes available.

What will my child(ren) do each day?

Elementary and Middle School Summer Journey students will attend exciting academic classes where they may read interesting adventure stories, play language arts games, and/or use technology to solve math mysteries. A daily schedule consists of academic classes of Reading, Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science or Social Studies. Students will also explore fun-filled courses for the first half of the program, followed by three different courses in the last half of the program.

How does the incentive program work?

Many students will win daily incentives for their efforts through a daily drawing or some similar format established by the summer site. Your student is also eligible to receive one of the following incentives for their *Summer Journey* attendance:

- 0 hours missed = \$100 gift card
- Up to 6.5 hours missed = \$75 gift card
- Over 6.5 and up to 13 hours missed = \$50 gift card

Will breakfast and lunch be served each day?

Yes, students will be served lunches using the same systems used during the regular school term. As a result, students should plan to purchase meals (or bring lunch) in the same way they do during the regular school year.

Attendance Incentives

Student incentives are dependent on attendance.

\$100 Shopping Card

Perfect attendance - 0 hours missed

\$75 Shopping Card

Up to 6.5 hours* missed

\$50 Shopping Card

Over 6.5 hours, up to 13 hours* missed

* 6.5 hours is the equivalent of one day missed. *13 hours is the equivalent of two days missed.

Gift cards can be used in the local stores or malls. The attendance incentives are contingent on actual (fullday) attendance in the *Summer Journey*[™] program.

Lincoln County R-III Summer Journey™ Course Offerings

All **Academic Courses** (Language Arts, Mathematics, Reading, Science and/or Social Studies) are offered during morning sessions. All *Journey Courses* are offered during afternoon sessions. Students participate in *Journey* courses for two week blocks, enabling every student to participate in six *Journey* courses.

Kindergarten

(students entering K in the Fall) Adventures in My Own Backyard

Kindergarten "explorers" respond with fascination and wonder as they explore habitats typically found in their own backyard. Multisensory activities are used extensively, providing opportunities for meaningful engagement with the learning process. Students' knowledge of the natural world is fostered along with concepts such as color and shape recognition, fine-motor development, phonemic awareness, and counting and sorting. This unit offers multi-level activities and is appropriate for districts with a wide variance in student population, including children with little or no previous school experience.

Camp K

In the afternoon portion of the Kindergarten day, students head to their campsite for quiet time as they rest and listen to the sounds of nature. Then they hit the trail to explore concepts about camping and nature through theme-related and physical movement activities. During Backpack Activity Stations, students develop cooperation skills as they investigate manipulatives and create art. From examining wildlife tracks to sharing campfire stories, young campers enjoy their adventures at Camp K.
